## Changing of the work plan because of the COVID-19 pandemic

M. Jurković has informed all of the participants that the transfer of the first portion of the project funds to each partner has been put into motion. Due to the Europe-wide travel restrictions because of the COVID-19 pandemic, the work plan of the project should be changed in a way that the work on Intellectual Output (the curriculum for Master's programme *Landscape Cultural Heritage Manager*) will come first and all of the activities will be postponed.

A. Chavarria has offered to send to all of the partners a handbook she published on historical landscape study, which is used in courses on this subject on The University of Padova to serve as guidance for drafting the project's curriculum. All of the participants agreed.

M. Jurković has also pointed out that the courses should be planned also on the subjects of sociology and economy. A. Chavarria said that we could compare them with similar courses in The University of Padova, while Mia Trentin will provide content on the technical aspect of the curriculum. Everyone agreed that the first draft should be done by the end of August.

## The new dates of Learning, Teaching and Training Activities (LTTA)

M. Jurković has suggested the first LTTA (a workshop in Rab) to be held in September, but the partners objected to this as it will be too early for students from Italy, France and Cyprus to travel. A. Chavarria stated that all of the Erasmus travel programs are cancelled and that we should ask for a one-year delay. Everyone agreed with the delay and the first workshop (LTTA) in Rab is now scheduled for June 2021. In the meantime, all of the partners will work on Intellectual Output (the curriculum) and its results will be tested on workshops (LTTA).

The meeting was adjourned by Miljenko Jurković at 07:30 PM (UTC+1).
